WHITE WINES

House White // 225 Sauvignon (Barton & Joyeux) 2019

13% // Sauvignon Blanc // Bordeaux (AOC), France
 M £5.1 // L £7.3 // M Carafe £14.7 // L Carafe £22

Originally from France, this classic Sauvignon Blanc offers zesty citrus and fresh grass on the nose, with a touch of exotic fruit. The palate delivers creamy, rounded spice and intense lemon flavours, making it a versatile choice to enjoy with our menus.

Verdejo (Bodegas Latue) 2023

13% // Verdejo // Toledo, Spain

The Verdejo grape, originally from North Africa and first planted in Spain in the 11th century, was once used for oxidative, Sherry-like wines. Today, it's crafted in a fresh, crisp, fruit-forward style with intense aromas of ripe tropical fruits, grapefruit, and aromatic spices. Crisp and zesty, if you enjoy Sauvignon Blanc, you'll love this exciting new offering from Bodegas Latue.

Grüner Veltliner (Meinklang Estate) 2022

12% // Grüner Veltliner // Meinklang, Burgenland, Austria

Grüner Veltliner, an Austrian grape variety, has outshone Burgundian Chardonnays at international competitions, impressed critics, and become a sommelier favourite for its excellent food-pairing qualities. Despite this, it's still not widely known—until now. With lovely citrus and mineral freshness, followed by a lively white pepper finish, this wine showcases the exciting potential of Austrian wines and pairs wonderfully with spicier dishes on the menu.

ORANGE WINES

Arrogant Frog (Paul Mas) 2023

13% // Grenache Blanc, Grenache Gris, Macabeu // Languedoc-Roussillon, France

A new orange wine from Domaines Paul Mas that gets its special colour from extended skin contact with the white grapes Grenache Blanc, Grenache Gris and Macabeu. Fruit-driven and unique in style with fresh citrus and spice aromas as well as approachable tannins. This is a delicious textural wine that's a great match with a wide variety of bold flavoured dishes.

Rare Orange (Chateau Maris) 2022

13.5% // Muscat // Languedoc-Roussillon, France

The Muscat grapes are treated to a prolonged skin contact and fermented at red wine temperatures, this gives the wine a deeper colour, more flavour, and a very slight tannic sensation. A very fresh orange wine with bright notes of summer fruits including white peach, apricot and candied fruit flavours. Dry with a little presence of tannin on the finish



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RED WINES

House Red // Montepulciano (Chiusa Grande) 2019

Bright and vivid with lovely cherry and berry fruits, showing nice freshness and a bit of structure. Stylish and characterful, with some hints of balsamic and a refined finish.

Adobe Camenere (Emiliana organic) 2022



13.5% // Camenere // Colchagua Valley, Chile

This wine suits all seasons, with sappy red cherry fruits and a peppery finish perfect for summer evenings, and aromas of black pepper, clove, and red cherry bringing warmth in colder months. Bold and characterful, it's ideal for savouring on its own or pairing with rich, hearty dishes.

Luna Gaia (Cantina Orsogna) 2022



12.5% // Nerello Mascalese // Abruzzo, Italy

The 2022 vintage of Nerello Mascalese, Sicily's star variety, delivers bold character. Grown in mineral-rich volcanic soils near Mount Etna, it offers smoky minerality, vibrant red cherry fruit, and a nimble body that dances on the palate. Its colourful label celebrates the Sicilian puppet opera, a cherished storytelling tradition.

ROSÉ WINES

Bohem Rosé (Bodegas Latue Bohem) 2023



13% // Tempranillo // La Mancha, Spain

From the hillside vineyards of Bodegas Latúe. It is a typically deeply coloured Spanish rosé, so unlike the in-vogue Provence pale style, but that's a good thing with just too many look-alikes flooding the shelves. This has an inviting strawberries and cream nose, a little touch of cappuccino adding to the appeal. In the mouth is it perhaps just flirting with off-dry? But a sweep of that pulpy strawberry fruit, good acidity and a bit of Tempranillo spice gives a savoury finish.

Rosé Fruité (Château de Rousset) 2023



12.5% // Grenache, Syrah, Vermentino // Chateau de Rousset, France

With its delicate salmon pink colour, this thrilling rosé surely has one foot firmly in the Provence camp. Grenache, Syrah and Vermentino predominate, providing a delicate, elegant wine with a soft, smooth mouthfeel. The red berried flavours come through and are carried on fresh and crisp balancing acidity. A rosé with flair and finesse, that will please all that try it.

Pet Nat Bianco (Integro Colline Pescaresi) NV



12% // Chardonnay // Abruzzo, Italy

Bottle £39

An organic Chardonnay Frizzante without sulphite or added sugar. A fresh sparkling wine that sometimes has a cloudy appearance as unfiltered natural fermentation. Unique straw colour with fragrant nose it has a purity of expression and panache. Lively fizz at every sip!

Pet Nat Rosé (Integro Colline Pescaresi) NV



12% // Cabernet // Abruzzo, Italy

Unique cherry colour with intense fragrant fruity nose with marked notes of pomegranate and cherry. This Sparkling rose has a purity of expression fresh and sapid with good persistence and fruity aftertaste.

Fleury (Champagne Fleury) NV



12% // Pinot Noir, Chardonnay // Champagne, France

The first ever biodynamic cuvée in Champagne! Europe, which witnessed the fall of the Berlin Wall, inspired the name of this wine. 85% Pinot Noir and 15% Chardonnay, the ethereal and floral Chardonnay brings a special elegance to this cuvée. Despite at first receiving a dosage, it has been zero-dosage for the last 10 years. A bright gold robe carries aromas of honey and acacia with a mouthfeel that's ample and generous with a surprising freshness. This is a chiselled wine, mouth-wateringly vibrant, with a touch of salinity. Perfect for celebrating at Nowhere.
