WHITE WINES

House White // Sauvignon Blanc (Vin De France) 2024



12% // Sauvignon Blanc // Loire, France

M £5.5 // L £8 // M Carafe £15.6 // L Carafe £23.4

Citrus and crispiness all the way. A great quality zippy fresh white wine. The vineyard operates a 'lutte raisonnee' approach using as little external treatments as possible. The result is delicious, clean, with uplifting notes of elder-flower, cut grass, asparagus and crunchy apples

Viognier (Petit Roubie) 2022



13.5% // Viognier // Languedoc-Roussillon, France

M £7.5 // L £10.7 // Bottle £32.1

This organic Viognier is bristling with exotic, ripe fruit and a luscious mouthfeel. Mango, apricot and peach flavours are typical for Viognier, as is the beautifully smooth and creamy texture. An excellent white that's decadent with balancing acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand) 2024



12.5% // Sauvignon Blanc // Marlborough, New Zealand

Bottle £35

Vinified entirely in stainless steel, this super-expressive, vivacious Marlborough Sauvignon captures the essence of the character contained within the grapes growing on these alluvial soils. Punchy, verdant and crisp, the citrus/gooseberry impact on the senses is further enhanced by delightful notes of passionfruit and exotic fruits.

ORANGE WINES

Animalia (Emiliana) 2022



13% // Sauvignon // Casablanca Valley, Chile

M £7.2 // L £10.3 // Bottle £31

This orange wine from Emiliana is made from 100% fresh Sauvignon Blanc grapes sourced from vineyards in the Casablanca Valley. With high humidity rates, its average temperatures reach 25°C in summer and 14°C in winter. The grapes were destemmed and crushed, and left with their skins then fermented in concrete tanks before aged in concrete eggs for five months with their skins (hence an 'orange wine'). It's golden orange in colour with a good structure on the palate with lush notes of ripe stone fruits and dried herbs on the nose followed by a subtle grassy Sauvignon tang.

Rare Orange (Chateau Maris) 2022



13.5% // Muscat // Languedoc-Roussillon, France

Bottle £36.9

The Muscat grapes are treated to a prolonged skin contact and fermented at red wine temperatures, this gives the wine a deeper colour, more flavour, and a very slight tannic sensation. A very fresh orange wine with bright notes of summer fruits including white peach, apricot and candied fruit flavours. Dry with a little presence of tannin on the finish

RED WINES

House Red // Montepulciano (Chiusa Grande) 2019



13% // Montepulciano // Abruzzo, Italy

Bright and vivid with lovely cherry and berry fruits, showing nice freshness and a bit of structure. Stylish and characterful, with some hints of balsamic and a refined finish.

Adobe Camenere (Emiliana) 2022



13.5% // Camenere // Colchagua Valley, Chile

This wine suits all seasons, with sappy red cherry fruits and a peppery finish perfect for summer evenings, and aromas of black pepper, clove, and red cherry bringing warmth in colder months. Bold and characterful, it's ideal for savouring on its own or pairing with rich, hearty dishes.

Primitivo (Cantina Orsogna) 2022



14% // Primitivo // Puglia, Italy

Bottle £35

Primitivo is a dark-skinned grape known for producing rich, inky, full bodied wines. This classic Primitivo from the South of Italy is intensely flavoured and deeply coloured. It caused significant consternation on both sides of the Atlantic when DNA analysis proved that Zinfandel and Primitivo are the same variety. A delicious wild berry character delivers a full-flavoured and concentrated palate.

ROSÉ WINES

Reserva Rosé (Emiliana) 2024



12% // Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah/Shiraz // Rapel Valleys, Chile

M £5.5 // L £7.8 // Bottle £23.3

An organic rosé with plenty of character. Big, bold strawberry and plum fruit flavours are generous and forward, making this a deliciously appealing drinking experience. 85% Syrah and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon.

Rosé Fruité (Château de Rousset) 2023



12.5% // Grenache, Syrah, Vermentino // Chateau de Rousset, France

Bottle £31.8

With its delicate salmon pink colour, this thrilling rosé surely has one foot firmly in the Provence camp. Grenache, Syrah and Vermentino predominate, providing a delicate, elegant wine with a soft, smooth mouthfeel. The red berried flavours come through and are carried on fresh and crisp balancing acidity. A rosé with flair and finesse, that will please all that try it.

Pet Nat Bianco (Integro Colline Pescaresi) NV



12% // Chardonnay // Abruzzo, Italy

Bottle £41.4

An organic Chardonnay Frizzante without sulphite or added sugar. A fresh sparkling wine that sometimes has a cloudy appearance as unfiltered natural fermentation. Unique straw colour with fragrant nose it has a purity of expression and panache. Lively fizz at every sip!

Pet Nat Rosé (Integro Colline Pescaresi) NV



12% // Cabernet // Abruzzo, Italy

Bottle £41.4

Unique cherry colour with intense fragrant fruity nose with marked notes of pomegranate and cherry. This Sparkling rose has a purity of expression fresh and sapid with good persistence and fruity aftertaste.

Fleury (Champagne Fleury) NV



12% // Pinot Noir, Chardonnay // Champagne, France

Bottle £63.6

The first ever biodynamic cuvée in Champagne! Europe, which witnessed the fall of the Berlin Wall, inspired the name of this wine. 85% Pinot Noir and 15% Chardonnay, the ethereal and floral Chardonnay brings a special elegance to this cuvée. Despite at first receiving a dosage, it has been zero-dosage for the last 10 years. A bright gold robe carries aromas of honey and acacia with a mouthfeel that's ample and generous with a surprising freshness. This is a chiselled wine, mouth-wateringly vibrant, with a touch of salinity. Perfect for celebrating at Nowhere.
